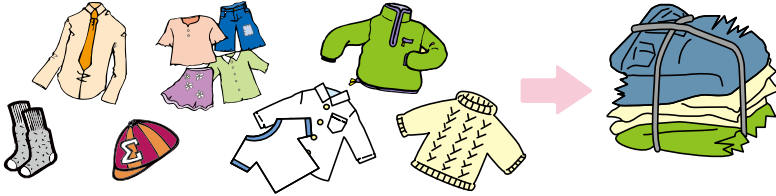


# Used Clothing

Collection days	Collection Area	Disposal Method
Twice a Month	Recyclable Collection Area	Tie with a string in a cross pattern

You don't need to remove buttons and fasteners.

Clothing · Sheet · Towel · Handkerchief etc.



- Used Clothing will be reused as solid fuels, so you don't have to worry about **wrinkles** or **damage**.
- Please do not throw out Used Clothing on **rainy days**.
- You can also dispose of clothes in **clear plastic bags**.

Things that don't fall under this category. (Example)

- Futons ● Cushions ● Curtains
- Leather Products ● Underwear
- Pillows ● Carpet



Fall under "Burnable Trash". (See Page8)

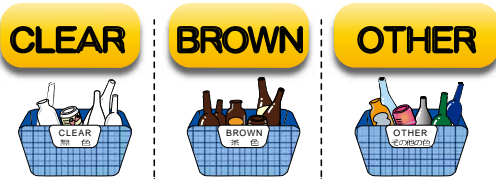
# Empty Bottles

Collection days	Collection Area	Disposal Method
Twice a Month	Recyclable Collection Area	Place in a container.

Separate into **3 Types**

You don't need to remove labels.

**A Point About Disposal**



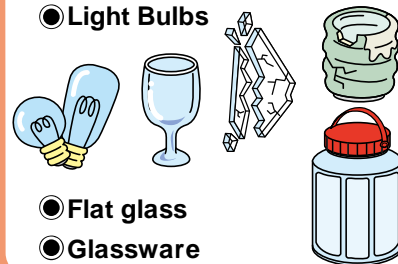
Take off the **Lids**



And gently **drain** the contents

Things that don't fall under this category. (Example)

- Ceramics ● Glass
- Light Bulbs
- Flat glass
- Glassware



Fall under "Unburnable Trash". (See Page9)

- We collect glass bottles that had **product** inside them. (Except for makeup bottles that are milky white, and oil bottles)
- Metal lids are "Unburnable Trash", and plastic lids fall under "Plastic Containers and Packaging".
- If you're in the Togo area, please dispose of empty bottles in clear plastic bags.

※ The blue containers placed at the Recyclable Collection Area are for "Empty bottles" only. Please do not use them for other recyclable items.

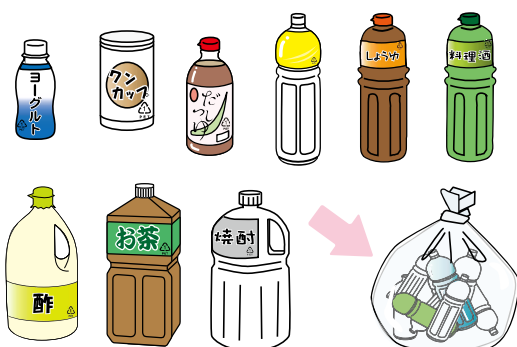
# Pet Bottles

Collection days	Collection Area	Disposal Method
Twice a Month	Recyclable Collection Area	Fully transparent bag (15~45ℓ)

Attention  mark

Soft Drinks, Alcohol  
Soy Sauce, etc.

**A Point About Disposal**



Take off the **Lids & Labels**



And gently **drain** the contents

**Don't crush it**

Things that don't fall under this category. (Example)

- Shampoo Containers
- Detergent Containers
- Lids & Labels
- Oil Containers

Fall under "Plastic". (See Page7)

- Anything that has the  Mark falls under this category.
- Cooking oil bottles and other colored bottles are also part of this category.
